We held our first annual Drive Against Childhood Cancer Golf Tournament Fundraiser in which we raised over \$8,000. It was a huge success with over 100 golfers participating.

Once again the annual Guns-N-Hoses Charity Hockey Game was a success with some new donors and opportunities provided to the foundation. A very generous donor provided tickets to an

Everblades game so that kids from the hospital could get to go for free.

We far exceeded our foundation fundraising goal which was set at \$5,000 dollars. In 2011 we were able to raise well over \$13,000, more than doubling our fundraising goal. To all of those who supported us in one way or another, Thank You!

The board of directors and I have strived to ensure that the foundation is run with the goal of fulfilling our mission as well as using as little money as possible to ensure that the maximum amount of money we receive from
